Children in grades Pre-K(3) through 12 are eligible to be identified as gifted. The purpose of the **Talented Program** is to provide experiences to students in grades K – 12 that demonstrate a high skill level and knowledge of one or more of the following disciplines: Theatre, Music (vocal or instrumental), and/or Visual Art.

The first step to identifying a gifted or talented child is to perform a screening test. Once the screening has been completed, it will be forwarded to the Gifted and Talented Office where the parent will be notified and the next steps will be determined.
