



Meet the Teacher

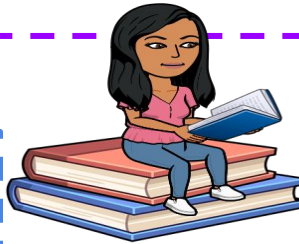
THE BASICS:



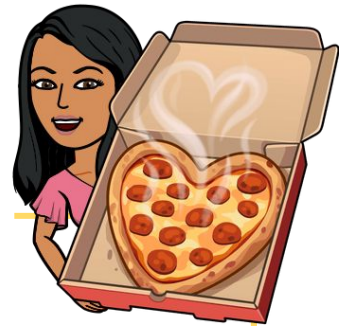

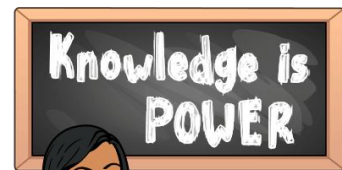
